Protocol for parents of DB Pirates players

Playing level	Parent's responsibility
Rugby Minis, Netters, Hockey Minis	An adult <u>must</u> accompany the child to all training and matches, at all times.
Rugby Youth Junior Netball	If the child is attending training and games unaccompanied, please make sure that they have their Hong Kong ID card with them at all times for emergency purposes.
Parents out of the country	If you are out of the country, it is essential that you have appointed a temporary legal guardian for your child to make medical decisions in your absence.

Registering your child for eHRSS

In the case of your child suffering an acute injury, illness or allergies to medication etc, you have the option of registering for Hong Kong's eHRSS. Your child's information will immediately be accessible to hospital staff. You can register for a child aged under 16 if you are his/her parent or guardian.

What is the eHRSS?

The eHR Sharing System (eHRSS) is a Government-funded, territory-wide information infrastructure that enables registered healthcare providers (HCPs) in both the public and private sectors, with the informed consent of the registered patient and proper authorisation, to view and share the eHRs of a patient in the appropriate electronic format within the sharable scope on a "Need-to-know" basis for healthcare purposes.
